

St. Anastasia Cemetery 2010 Memorials

Prairie Grass and Wildflower Parcel

Cost: \$200 each, includes ground prep, seeding, and memorial plaque

Quantity: 8

Placement: In the new North development area, directly over the county tile work (this is a component of St. A Cemetery Phase II Beautification Project).

Description: Each 900 sq ft parcel comprises the designated area and will be a restored prairie habitat of native plants, song birds, and butterflies. It will be protected and kept natural (un-mowed). Planning was done with professional input from Prairie Restorations, Inc, of Princeton, MN.



Granite Benches

Cost: \$1,900 each, includes installation and engraving

Quantity: 1

Placement: In front of the new columbarium

Description: This 4 ft. bench is made of Carnelian granite, the same as our mausoleum and columbarium structures. The granite is fully polished. Includes an engraved memorial statement, up to 25 words, along the edge of the seat (i.e. In Memory of the Smith Family). Additional letters will have a slight up charge of \$2.50 per word.



Black Hills Spruce Tree

Cost: \$200 each, includes installation, and memorial plaque

Quantity: 3

Placement: Landscape area along the SW and NW property line

Description: This evergreen conifer tree is a dense symmetrical cone shape. Bright green needles mature to an interesting blue-green. Great landscape accent, useful as a windbreak or screening. Full sun. Slow grower to 20-25 ft. Planted from a 2-gal size.



Red Twig Dogwood Bush

Cost: \$100 each, includes installation, and memorial plaque

Quantity: 2

Placement: Landscape area along the West property line

Description: This deciduous shrub has a thicket of upright blood red stems, very showy in the winter. Useful in all seasons as a naturalizing effect. Full to partial sun. Moderate grower to 6-8 ft. Planted from a 2-gal size.
