#### Phase One Project Completed Thanks To You

Thanks to your ongoing financial support, we were able to raise nearly \$1.6 million for the first phase of our facility master plan program. Of that total, we used \$1.1 million to renovate the worship space with beauty, upgrades, and safety concerns all addressed. We have nearly \$486,000 in reserves to begin our second phase of the master plan program. In addition, we were able to complete another \$582,000 of needed repairs and upgrades throughout the campus (see below). Some of the financial support came from outside grants that we received, as we are cognizant of the monies being spent and are constantly looking for other funding sources.

We were also able to maintain a balanced operating budget while all of this was taking place. We have no debt and are showing very positive financial numbers! We accomplished all of this during very difficult times, as COVID and other personal issues strained families throughout our parish community. Praise God and know that our collective stewardship of Time, Talent, and Treasure will never equal what He is willing to give those who believe and trust in Him.




#### Phase Two Project Prayer


# Proposed Phase Two Remodel and Finishes




# Proposed Kitchen Floor Plan

# Proposed Church and School Offices Floor Plan





### Timeline of Capital Campaign Activity

May 2023 – August 2023: Capital Campaign begins with a quiet phase of advance gifts.

**September 2023:** Circles of Support invitation to parish volunteers.

October 2023: In-Church invitation to "open wide the doors" and invite support from all remaining registered households.

November 2023: Personal Contact to encourage more decisions.

**December 1, 2023 – November 30, 2026:** Three-year pledge term for payment of capital campaign financial commitments.
